Serving as The Seattle School's second President for 7 years (following 5 years of service as Academic Dean), Dr. Anderson lead our institution through full accreditation from the Association of Theological Schools, the birth of The Allender Center, a new name, seven years of sustained enrollment growth, and numerous new faculty and staff hires and curricular iterations.

THE ALLENDER CENTER

Over the past seven years, we have moved The Allender Center from an idea to a flourishing reality resulting in 16,500 people participating in life changing experiences, 785,000 downloads of our podcast, and a team of 45 people working to steward and extend the mission of The Allender Center in communities across the nation and around the globe. We believe this has been possible due to our mission of linking the story of God with our stories, our expertise in addressing trauma and abuse, and our unique theory on how healing takes place in the human heart.

What an incredible privilege it has been for the Allender Center to create space for this sacred work of engaging the impact of harm for the purpose of healing and restoration.



FORUM & THE OTHER JOURNAL

Our Forum invites individuals from the Pacific Northwest, across the country, and around the globe to the table for thoughtful engagement and meaningful dialogue. In 2016-17 we curated 11 offerings with more than 110 presenters and conversation partners for more than 1,200 participants.
